Paying Your Plan Premium:

If we determine that you owe a late enrollment penalty, we need to know how you would prefer to pay it. You can pay by mail, Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) or credit card each month. You can also choose to pay your premium by automatic deduction from your Social Security benefit check each month.

People with limited incomes may qualify for extra help to pay for their prescription drug costs. If eligible, Medicare could pay for 75% of drug costs including monthly prescription drug premiums, annual deductibles, and co-insurance. Additionally, those who qualify will not be subject to the coverage gap or a late enrollment penalty. Many people are

eligible for these savings and don't even know it. For more information about this extra help, contact your local Social Security office, or call Social Security at 1-800-772-1213. TTY users should call 1-800-325-0778. You can also apply for extra help online at www.socialsecurity.gov/prescriptionhelp.

If you qualify for extra help with your Medicare prescription drug coverage costs, Medicare will pay all or part of your plan premium. If Medicare pays only a portion of this premium, we will bill you for the amount that Medicare doesn't cover.

If you currently have health coverage from an employer or union, joining Texas Community Care could affect your employer or union health benefits. You could lose your employer or union health coverage if you join Texas Community Care. Read the communications your employer or union sends you. If you have questions, visit their website, or contact the office listed in their communications. If there isn't any information on whom to contact, your benefits administrator or the office that answers questions about your coverage can help.

By completing this enrollment application, I agree to the following:

Texas Community Care is a Medicare Advantage plan and has a contract with the Federal government.

I will need to keep my Medicare Parts A and B. I can only be in one Medicare Advantage plan at a time and I understand that my enrollment in this plan will automatically end my enrollment in another Medicare health plan or prescription drug plan. It is my responsibility to inform you of any prescription drug coverage that I have or may get in the future. Enrollment in this plan is generally for the entire year. Once I enroll, I may leave this plan or make changes only at certain times of the year when an enrollment period is available (Example: November 15 – December 31 of every year), or under certain special circumstances, by sending a request to Texas Community Care or by calling 1-800-MEDICARE. TTY users should call 1-877-486-2048, 24 hours a day/7 days a week.

Texas Community Care serves a specific service area. If I move out of the area that Texas Community Care serves, I need to notify the plan so I can disenroll and find a new plan in my new area. Once I am a member of Texas Community Care, I have the right to appeal plan decisions about payment or services if I disagree. I will read the Evidence of Coverage document from Texas Community Care when I get it to know which rules I must follow in order to get coverage with this Medicare Advantage plan. I understand that people with Medicare aren't usually covered under Medicare while out of the country except for limited coverage near the U.S. border.

I understand that beginning on the date Texas Community Care coverage begins, I must get all of my health care from Texas Community Care, except for emergency or urgently needed services or out-of-area dialysis services. Services authorized by Texas Community Care and other services contained in my Texas Community Care Evidence of Coverage document (also known as a member contract or subscriber agreement) will be covered. Without authorization, **NEITHER MEDICARE NOR TEXAS COMMUNITY CARE WILL PAY FOR THE SERVICES.**

I understand that if I am getting assistance from a sales agent, broker, or other individual employed by or contracted with Texas Community Care, he/she may be paid based on my enrollment in Texas Community Care. Counseling services may be available in my state to provide advice concerning Medicare supplement insurance or other Medicare Advantage or Prescription Drug plan options as well as medical assistance through the state Medicaid program and the Medicare Savings Program.
